Pursuant to Article 43 of the Statute of the Šibenik University of Applied Sciences, the Professional Council of the Šibenik University of Applied Sciences, at its 18th session held on 19 December 2024, regarding the conditions of enrolment in the 1st year of professional undergraduate studies of the Šibenik University of Applied Sciences in the academic year 2025/2026, based on a public tender, adopted the following

DECISION

on the criteria for enrolment in professional undergraduate studies at the Šibenik University of Applied Sciences
in the academic year 2025/2026.

I.

The ranking of candidates for enrolment of students in the first year of professional studies of Tourism Management, Business Informatics, Traffic and Administrative Law carried out at the Šibenik University of Applied Sciences is conducted based on the evaluation of grades from high school and the results achieved at the state graduation exam.

The ranking of candidates for enrolment of students in the first year of the professional undergraduate study of Nursing, which is carried out at the Šibenik University of Applied Sciences, is carried out on the basis of the evaluation of high school grades, results achieved at the state graduation exam and other additional special achievements – years of work experience in nursing.

Candidates are required to have a minimum of B level in the subjects covered by the compulsory part of the state graduation exam.

For candidates who are citizens of EU Member States, the first foreign language that they passed as part of their externally evaluated final exam is recognised instead of the Croatian language at the state graduation exam.

Candidates who completed at least four years of secondary education in the Republic of Croatia before 2010 and candidates who completed secondary education outside the Republic of Croatia can take the State Matura exams, but they can also apply for the study program if they do not pass the State Matura exams, but in that case they do not receive points related to that part of the evaluation.

II.

The conditions that will be applied in the classification procedure for enrolment in the professional undergraduate studies of Tourism Management, Computing, Traffic and Administrative Law of the Šibenik University of Applied Sciences in the academic year 2025/2026 will be evaluated according to the following ratios:
